It's been another different year, hasn't it?

BODY

As the end of 2021 approaches, I've been thinking about all that this year has held. I've been noticing the ways in which art has carried me.

I've also been thinking of you.

In what ways has art carried you this year? Did a song carry part of your 2021 story? A movie? A sculpture, an outdoor play, a novel? It's a funny thing to think about.

I invite you to pay attention during these final months of 2021. Notice art that touches you. Look for art that carries part of your story.

Art doesn't have to cost anything. Stream music on your phone. Spend time near outdoor installation art. Where it is safe to do so, attend a free live performance. Mask up and wander the halls of a public museum. Read poetry online.

When you find something (and it is permissible to do so), take a picture. Record a video. Share a link. Post the art that moved you on Instagram and Facebook. Tell your story.

Tag #artcarriesourstories. Tag friends who might like to share their stories, or see yours.

For my part, from 10.1.21—12.31.21, I will post one of my paintings on [Instagram](#) and [Facebook](#) every few days at [@sylvialippmannart](#). I will post only the visual image; no name, no description.

Which of my pieces carry your 2021 story? Take a moment. Look close. What part of your story do the images reflect? Of what do they remind you? Of whom?

The connection can be personal or collective. A loss, an accomplishment. A struggle, a new beginning. A heartbreak, a celebration. A world crisis, an individual triumph. Art carries all of our stories.

Usually, *we artists* name our works. *We* tell their stories. This year, my art is yours. *You* name it. *You* tell its story.

Social media offers unlimited space to respond, and art holds space for infinite human stories. Even if there are already 300 comments, your story is important. Add yours.

My mission is to offer my art to the people and stories of 2021. By year's end, I hope to find for each painting at least one person who senses a name for it, and for whom it carries a story.

I honor you, gentle warriors of 2021. May my art carry your stories.

Original works and prints remain for sale during #ArtCarriesOurStories 2021. If you are moved to purchase an original work during this time period, a few unique opportunities are available:

01 | If you wish, the name the painting carries for you can become its official name. Images of your purchased original will permanently hold that name in my online galleries.

02 | Likewise, if you wish, the story the painting carries for you can become its official story. You will have the option to share the story in your own words, and have it listed with the painting on my website. With your permission, I will share it on my social media and email accounts.

03 | If you wish, you may designate a 501(c)(3) charity to receive 5% of the proceeds from print or product sales bearing the image of your purchased original. The donation accrual period will begin on the date of purchase, and continue through December 31, 2022. (If your painting is not yet listed as a print, it soon will be!)

04 | In an effort to make original art accessible to all, **original works** will be discounted 20% for the month of October 2021, discounted 15% in November 2021, and discounted 10% in December 2021. Please note that original works must be purchased before **[date]** to ensure arrival by Christmas. Standard shipping is always free. Please see the General Purchasing FAQ below for delivery timetables for prints.
